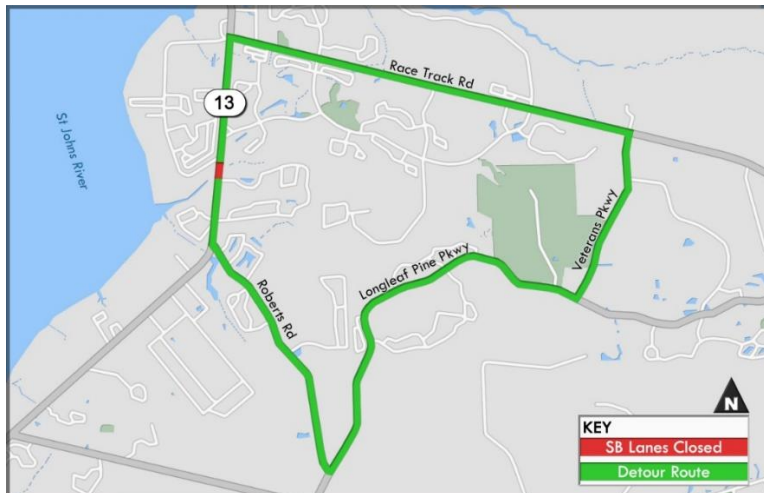

ICYMI: Southbound State Road 13 to be Detoured for Reconstruction Work

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation will temporarily detour traffic on southbound State Road 13 starting tonight, Friday, May 14 at 10 p.m. through 5 a.m. Monday, May 17.

As shown in the map below, drivers attempting to travel southbound on State Road 13 will be detoured to Race Track Road, Veterans Parkway and Longleaf Pine Parkway to Roberts Road where they can access southbound State Road 13.



This detour will facilitate reconstruction work as part of FDOT’s State Road 13 resurfacing project from Mill Creek to the Duval County line.
