ICYMI: FDOT to Host Public Hearing for Proposed Median Modification on U.S. 1

St. Augustine, Fla. – A public hearing regarding a proposed median modification on U.S. 1 (State Road 5) in St. Augustine will be held Monday, June 3 at the St. Augustine Main Library, 1960 N. Ponce DeLeon Boulevard, St. Augustine, FL 32084. Attendees will have the opportunity to view displays and discuss the proposed changes with project staff and consultants during an open house from 4:30 to 6:30 p.m. A formal public comment period will begin at 6:30 p.m.

The Florida Department of Transportation is proposing to close the median south of the north Northrop Grumman entrance to reduce conflicts and meet current median opening spacing standards.

Project documents will be available for review at the public hearing and are currently posted on www.nflroads.com. Attendees who complete a speaker's card will be given the opportunity to make an oral statement that will become part of the public hearing record. Persons wishing to submit written statements or other exhibits in place of or in addition to oral statements may do so at the hearing or by sending them to Nelson Bedenbaugh, 1109 South Marion Avenue, Lake City, FL 32025. All exhibits or statements postmarked on or before June 13, 2019 will become part of the public hearing record.
