

ICYMI- Clet Harvey Road over Turkey Creek Bridge Replacement Project to Begin Feb. 5

GLEN ST. MARY, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation is replacing two bridges on Clet Harvey Road in Baker County, one over Turkey Creek and the other at Mud Lake Swamp. Work is expected to start Feb. 5 and the closure of the bridge over Turkey Creek is expected to start Feb. 20, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. Completion of the bridge over Turkey Creek is expected to take 5 months, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. Upon completion and opening of the bridge over Turkey Creek, construction will begin on the Mud Lake Swamp bridge.

Traffic will be maintained in accordance with FDOT design standards throughout the project. During the Turkey Creek bridge closure, traffic will detour via County Road 229, Mud Lake Road and Le Harvey Road as shown below:
