Intersection Improvement Project for Southside Boulevard at Atlantic Boulevard Begins Construction Next Week

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – Construction on an intersection improvement project on Southside Boulevard (SR 115) at Atlantic Boulevard (SR 10) is scheduled to begin next week.

Maer Homes, LLC was selected to complete the \$1.8 million project, which includes milling and resurfacing, base work, drainage improvements, curb and gutters, traffic signals, highway signing, sidewalks, and other incidental construction. Completion is estimated in late 2024, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

During construction, the public is encouraged to follow pedestrian detour signs and use caution in the area. Lane closures are not allowed during the following time periods Monday through Sunday:

- **Southside Boulevard Northbound:** 6 a.m. – 10 p.m.
- **Southside Boulevard Southbound:** 6 a.m. – 9 p.m.
- **Atlantic Boulevard Eastbound:** 6 a.m. – 10 p.m.
- **Atlantic Boulevard Westbound:** 6 a.m. – 10:30 p.m.
