J. Turner Butler Boulevard to See Overnight Detour Tuesday

Jacksonville, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation will detour J. Turner Butler Boulevard (SR 202) Tuesday, July 30 from 10 p.m. until 5 a.m. for overhead truss installation. The work is part of the ongoing Express Lanes project from State Road 9B to just north of J. Turner Butler Boulevard.


Drivers traveling west on J. Turner Butler Boulevard will be detoured to northbound I-295, to westbound Beach Boulevard (U.S. 90), to southbound Southside Boulevard (SR 115) and back to J. Turner Butler Boulevard.

Drivers traveling east on J. Turner Butler Boulevard will be detoured to southbound Southside Boulevard (SR 115). to eastbound Baymeadows Road (SR 152), to northbound I-295 and back to J. Turner Butler Boulevard.

This Express Lanes project consists of two new 12-foot travel lanes in each direction, the addition of noise walls along I-295 in various locations, the construction of drainage ponds and the installation of electronic tolling systems at various locations to collect tolls. The project will offer a choice for travelers to use an express lane for a fee or remain on the non-tolled portion of I-295.

The \$139.9 million project was awarded to the Archer-Western Contractors design-build team.
