Main Street Bridge to See Overnight Detours Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – The Main Street Bridge will see overnight detours in Downtown Jacksonville Monday, December 18 through Thursday, December 20 for routine maintenance activities. The detours will take place nightly from 9 p.m. until 4 a.m.

Drivers will be detoured to the Acosta Bridge; marine traffic will not be impacted by the closures.

The Florida Department of Transportation has a robust bridge maintenance program that protects taxpayer investments and ensures the structures receive preventative maintenance to extend the life of their investment.

The Main Street Bridge is a vertical lift bridge and is raised and lowered more than 1,400 times a year.
