Main Street Bridge will see nightly closure, beginning tonight, for the next two weeks

Jacksonville – Jacksonville’s Main Street Bridge will be closed tonight from 6:30 p.m. to Tuesday, October 17 at 6 a.m. and will close nightly the next two weeks as crews continue their work on rehabilitation of the structure.

Closures of the Main Street Bridge will follow the schedule below, as part of improvements to the mechanical, electrical and structural systems:

Monday, October 16 from 6:30 p.m. to 6 a.m.
Tuesday, October 17 from 6:30 p.m. to 6 a.m.
Wednesday, October 18 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
Thursday, October 19 from 6:30 p.m. to 6 a.m.
Friday, October 20 from 6:30 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Monday, October 23 from 6:30 p.m. to 6 a.m.
Tuesday, October 24 from 6:30 p.m. to 6 a.m.
Wednesday, October 25 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
Thursday, October 26 from 6:30 p.m. to 6 a.m.

During closures, both vehicular and pedestrian traffic will be detoured to the Acosta Bridge. Signs will direct traffic through the detour. Boaters will not be impacted by the closures.

M & J Construction of Tarpon Springs was awarded the \$10.7 million contract. The project is expected to be completed in fall 2017.
