### Media Availability: First Drive SR 312 Extension to Open Sept. 4

**ST. AUGUSTINE, Fla.** – Media is invited to a “first drive” of the State Road 312 extension in St. Johns County, Sept. 4 at 10 a.m. prior to the roadway opening to the public at 1 p.m.

Media will meet at 10 a.m. at SR 207 and SR 312. Crews will assist media navigating through barricades to the new roadway.

Construction operations for the SR 312 Extension project from SR 207 to South Holmes Boulevard are complete. The newly constructed lanes of SR 312 from SR 207 to South Holmes Boulevard will open Sept. 4 at approximately 1 p.m., weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Motorists are encouraged to use caution in the area during this time as drivers become accustomed to the new traffic alignment and signals.

Construction on the new, one-mile roadway began in mid-2022 and was performed by P & S Paving Inc. for \$12 million.
