Multiple Detours Planned for Next Week at the I-10 Widening Project

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of FDOT’s I-10 from I-295 to I-95 widening project, there will be multiple detours next week throughout the work area while crews perform bridge construction activities, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

I-10 West to Lane Avenue Off-Ramp: Sunday, Nov. 13th to Thursday, Nov. 17th from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. drivers will be detoured to I-295 north, take the Commonwealth Avenue exit and head east on Commonwealth Avenue to connect with Lane Avenue.

Cassat Avenue to I-10 East On-Ramp: Sunday, Nov. 13 through Thursday, Nov. 17 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., drivers who wish to take the I-10 east on-ramp will be detoured via Cassat Avenue to either Highway Avenue to Luna Street to connect with I-10 or Lenox Avenue to Luna Street to connect with I-10.

Luna Street Detour: Sunday, Nov. 13 through Thursday, Nov. 17 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Luna Street will be closed at I-10. Drivers will be detoured via Highway Avenue to Cassat Avenue to Lenox Avenue to reconnect with Luna Street or via Lenox Avenue to Cassat Avenue to Highway Avenue to reconnect with Luna Street.

Nelson Street Detour: Sunday, Nov. 13 through Thursday, Nov. 17 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Nelson Street will be closed at I-10. Drivers will be detoured via Lenox Avenue to Luna Street to Rayford Street or Rayford Street to McDuff Avenue to Lenox Avenue to reconnect with Nelson Street.

FDOT hired Superior Construction to complete this \$174.5 million project in early 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

The holidays are approaching. As traffic increases, let’s remember to be courteous drivers. Obey all posted speed limits, never drive impaired or distracted, be patient (no road rage) and always buckle up!
