Multiple Detours Planned for Next Week at the I-10/I-95 Interchange Improvements Project

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of bridge construction activities for the Florida Department of Transportation's I-10/I-95 Operational Improvements project, there will be multiple overnight detours around the I-10/I-95 interchange next week, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

I-95 North Detour: Monday, Oct. 31 from 10:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., drivers on I-95 north will be detoured to the Acosta Bridge, right on Broad Street and left on Adams Street to reconnect with I-95 north. Drivers who wish to connect with I-10 will take I-95 south to connect with I-10.

I-95 South Detour: Wednesday, Nov. 2 from 10:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., drivers on I-95 south will be detoured to the Forest Street exit, left on Forest Street and right on Park Street to rejoin I-95 southbound.

I-10 East Detour: Wednesday, Nov. 2 from 10:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., drivers on I-10 east who wish to access I-95 south will be detoured north to the Union Street exit, right on Jefferson Street to connect with the Acosta Bridge and rejoin I-95 southbound.

Stockton Street On-Ramp to I-10 West/I-95 Detour: Thursday, Nov. 3 from 10:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., the Stockton Street to I-10 east/I-95 on-ramp will be closed. Drivers who wish to take I-95 north will take Stockton Street north, right on Edison Avenue and right on Forest Street to connect with I-95 north. Drivers who wish to take I-95 South will take Stockton Street north, right on Edison Avenue, right on Forest Street, left on Park Street and take the Acosta Bridge to connect with I-95 South.

Forest Street On-Ramp to I-10 West Detour: Friday, Nov. 4 and Saturday, Nov. 5 from 10:30 p.m. to 6:30 a.m., drivers who wish to take the Forest Street on-ramp to I-10 will be detoured to Margaret Street/Edison Avenue, left on Claude Street/Irene Street and left at the signal to take the I-10 westbound on-ramp. Drivers who wish to take U.S. 17 (Roosevelt Boulevard) will continue on Edison Avenue and turn left on McDuff Avenue to connect with Roosevelt Boulevard.

I-95 South to I-10 West Exit Ramp 351A: Friday, Nov. 4 and Saturday, Nov. 5 from 10:30 p.m. to 6:30 a.m., drivers on I-95 south who wish to connect with I-10 must take exit 352D, which is prior to exit 351A for southbound I-95 traffic.

FDOT hired Archer Western to complete this \$126 million project in fall 2022, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

October is National Pedestrian Safety Month, and all roadway users share the responsibility for keeping everyone safe. Pedestrians should always use designated crosswalks and avoid distractions like using cell phones while walking. Motorists must yield to pedestrians in crosswalks and watch for pedestrians at all times. Together, we can reach the goal of ZERO pedestrian fatalities on Florida's roads.
