Nightly Detours Scheduled Next Week for Hendricks Avenue at San Marco Boulevard

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of intersection improvements on San Marco Boulevard at Hendricks Avenue (State Road 13), intermittent nightly detours of southbound San Marco Boulevard at Hendricks Avenue and northbound Hendricks Avenue at San Marco Boulevard are necessary for signal pole installation to be completed safely. The detours are scheduled to take place between 8 p.m. and 11:59 p.m. each day of the week starting on Sunday, Jan. 19 through Friday, Jan. 24. These detours will not be occurring simultaneously, crews will switch over as poles are installed.

At these times, drivers on southbound San Marco Boulevard seeking to access Hendricks Avenue will follow the detour to use Alford Place to Hendricks Avenue instead. Drivers on northbound Hendricks Avenue will follow the detour to use San Marco Boulevard to Alford Place to Hendricks Avenue instead. The detour maps for both routes are given below.

Janus Construction is estimated to complete the \$1.8 million intersection improvements by summer 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

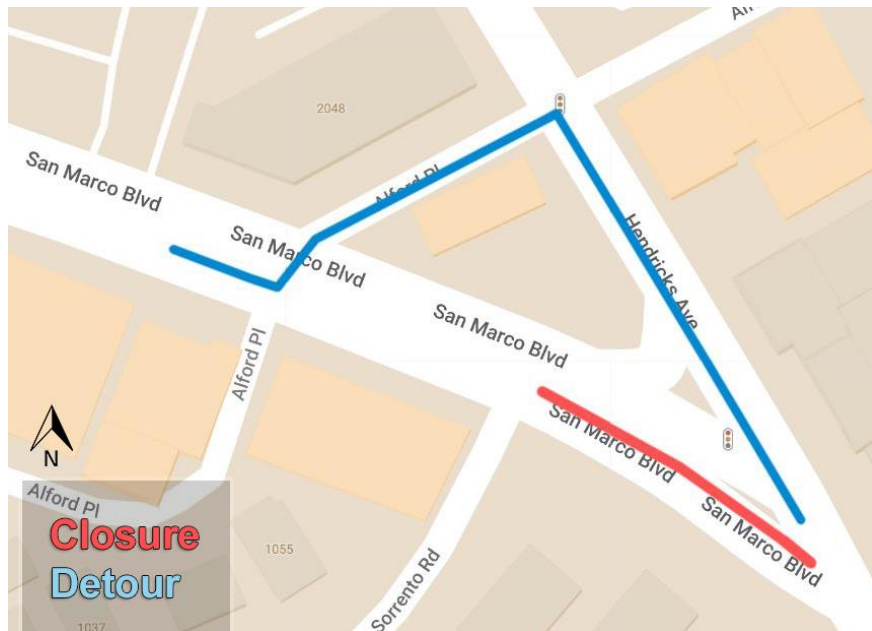
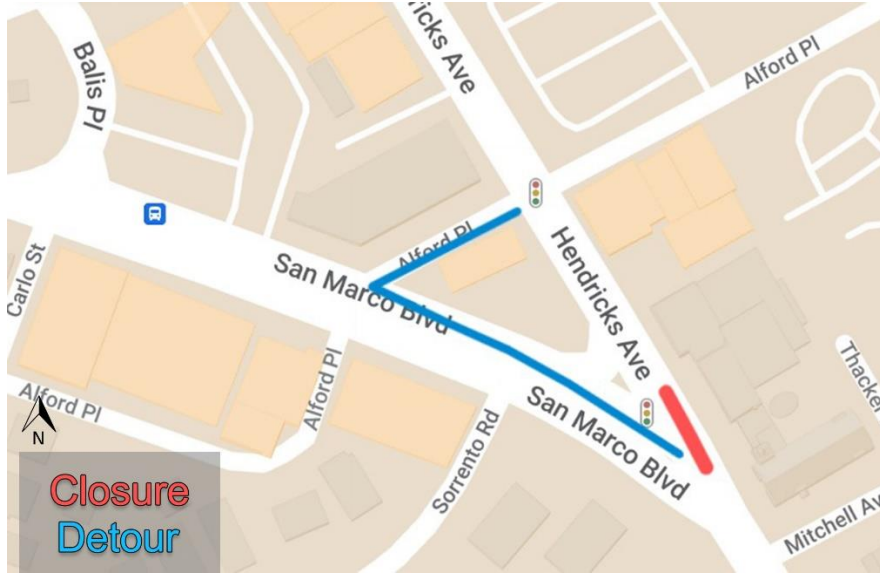
