Nightly Detours on Edgewood Avenue Planned June 18 to June 20

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – Drivers will encounter detours on Edgewood Avenue from Lenox Avenue to Mayflower Street for paving activities Tuesday, June 18 through Thursday, June 20, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

On Tuesday, June 18 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Edgewood Avenue will be closed to traffic between Lenox Avenue and Post Street for paving operations. On Wednesday, June 19, and Thursday June 20 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Edgewood Avenue will be closed to traffic between Mayflower Street and Post Street for paving operations. Drivers should use additional caution and follow posted detour signs.

FDOT selected Superior Construction to complete this \$7.66 million project in summer 2024, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
