Nightly Closures of I-295 Northbound Exit Ramp to Beach Boulevard Planned Nov. 7 through Nov. 9

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of the widening and resurfacing improvement project on I-295 from J.T. Butler Boulevard (SR 202) to Beach Boulevard (SR 212), nightly detours of the I-295 northbound exit ramp to Beach Boulevard are planned Tuesday, Nov. 7 through Thursday, Nov. 9. The ramp will close nightly at 10 p.m. and reopen by 5 a.m. the following morning.

During the closure, drivers will detour via westbound Town Center Parkway and northbound St. Johns Bluff Road to access Beach Boulevard.

Hubbard Construction Company, Inc. is expected to complete the \$19 million improvement project in late 2024, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
