FDOT to host second open house for I-95 Overland landscape project

Jacksonville – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is hosting its second open house to provide feedback to the community regarding its proposed landscaping of the Overland project.

The open house is Thursday, March 29, from 4:30-6:30 p.m. at the FDOT's Training Center Building, 2198 Edison Avenue, Jacksonville, Florida 32204.

Those interested can drop by anytime between 4:30-6:30 p.m. to learn more about the landscaping project and to speak to FDOT staff and project design consultants who will be available to answer concerns regarding the proposed project. The open house will be an informal event with 60% landscape plans available. No presentations will be made.

The landscaping project will include plantings of numerous species of trees, native palms, shrubs, ornamental grasses and vines. Also included is irrigation, hardscaping, soil work and other incidental work relating to the overall landscape for the downtown Interstate 95 corridor (see attached map). Construction is currently expected to start no later than summer 2019.

The proposed landscaping project has been developed through District Two's FDOTree program, a new initiative developed to promote communication and delivery of the Florida Department of Transportation's Northeast Florida landscaping program.
