### **Overnight Closure of Northbound Blanding Boulevard Planned June 10 for First Coast Expressway Construction**

**CLAY COUNTY, Fla.** – As part of First Coast Expressway construction, an overnight closure of northbound Blanding Boulevard (State Road 21) is planned Monday, June 10, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Northbound Blanding Boulevard from County Road 220 to Baxley Road will close at 11 p.m. Monday and reopen by 5 a.m. Tuesday, June 11. During the closure, traffic will detour via County Road 220 and Baxley Road.
