Overnight Closures of I-295 and Beach Boulevard Ramp Planned Aug. 18-22

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of the widening and resurfacing improvement project on I-295 from J.T. Butler Boulevard (SR 202) to Beach Boulevard (SR 212), nightly closures of I-295 from Beach Boulevard to Town Center Parkway and the I-295 North exit ramp to Beach Boulevard are planned Sunday, Aug. 18 to Thursday, Aug. 22.

- **I-295 South closed nightly from 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m.**: Drivers will detour via westbound Beach Boulevard, southbound St. Johns Bluff Road and eastbound Town Center Parkway to access I-295 South.
- **I-295 North/I-295 North ramp to Beach Boulevard closed nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.**: Drivers will detour via westbound Town Center Parkway and northbound St. Johns Bluff Road to access Beach Boulevard. Drivers will continue on eastbound Beach Boulevard to access I-295 North.

Hubbard Construction Company, Inc. is expected to complete the \$19 million improvement project in late 2024, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
