Overnight Closures of Ramps at University Boulevard, Hart Expressway Planned April 14-17

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of a resurfacing project on University Boulevard (State Road 109) from Cruz Road to Wateredge Lane, nightly closures of the on- and off-ramps at University Boulevard (State Road 109) and Hart Expressway (State Road 228) are planned Monday, April 14 through Thursday, April 17, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Closures will begin at 8 p.m. and end by 6 a.m. the following morning. During the closures, drivers should follow posted detour signage and use additional caution.

- Monday, April 14 and Wednesday, April 16: On- and off-ramps at southbound University Boulevard and Hart Expressway closed.
- Tuesday, April 15: Off-ramps from Hart Expressway to northbound University Boulevard closed.
- **Thursday, April 17:** On-ramp from northbound University Boulevard to Hart Expressway closed.

Watson Civil Construction, Inc. was awarded the contract for this \$6.85 million project, which includes milling and resurfacing 1.8 miles of roadway, pavement and curb reconstruction, signage, pavement markings, concrete sidewalks, guardrail replacement, pier protection, ADA detectable warning devices, stormwater drainage, signalization and lighting/light pole installation. The project is estimated for completion in spring 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
