Overnight Delays Expected Eastbound Arlington Expressway Planned this Week

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of a resurfacing project on Arlington Expressway (State Road 115) from Mathews Bridge to Southside Boulevard, eastbound Arlington Expressway is set to close at 9 p.m. Friday, June 21 and reopen by 6 a.m. Sunday, June 23 while crews perform concrete paving rehabilitation. Additionally, while the work does require a detour to the service road, it is not expected to significantly interrupt motorists. During the closure, drivers will detour via eastbound South Service Road to access the Arlington Expressway.

Motorists seeking to use Arlington Expressway overnight this weekend should plan ahead as the detour to the service roads does have traffic signals which may create delays. Law enforcement has been notified to assist with traffic control measures.

Superior Construction is expected to complete the \$26 million project in summer 2024, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
