Overnight Detour Planned Sunday at the State Road 16 Exit Ramp from I-95 South

ST. AUGUSTINE, Fla. – As part of resurfacing improvements on I-95 from State Road 207 to International Golf Parkway, a closure of the State Road 16 exit ramp from I-95 South is necessary for signalization work to be completed. The exit ramp will close nightly at 8 p.m. Sunday, April 21 and reopen by 6 a.m. the following morning.

During the closure, drivers on I-95 South seeking to access State Road 16 will exit at State Road 207 and use I-95 North to access State Road 16. Drivers are encouraged to use caution in the area and follow posted detour signs.

Anderson Columbia Co. Inc. is estimated to complete the \$31 million resurfacing improvements by early 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
