Overnight Detour Planned This Week for Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway (SR 115) ITS Improvements

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of the Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) improvements project on Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway (State Road 115) from Boulevard Street to Beach Boulevard, an overnight detour is scheduled Monday, Sept. 16 through Thursday, Sept. 19 for installation of a dynamic message sign (DMS) structure.

Eastbound Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway will be closed at the Haines Street and Jessie Street off-ramp exit starting on Monday, Sept. 16 through Thursday, Sept. 19 between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m. for installation of the sign structure.

As a detour, drivers will exit at the Haines Street/Jessie Street exit and continue onto Haines Street to Jessie Street, then continue straight onto the Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway on-ramp.

Chinchor Electric began the \$7.9 million Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) improvements in September 2023 and is estimated to complete the work by early 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
