### Overnight Detour Planned at I-10/I-95 Interchange

**JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** – As part of FDOT's I-10/I-95 Operational Improvements project, an overnight detour of the I-95 south to I-10 west exit ramp 351A will be in place Wednesday, January 13 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

**Detour route:** Drivers on I-95 south who wish to connect with I-10 west must take exit 352D then take exit 351B to connect with I-10 west.

FDOT hired Archer Western to complete this \$126 million project in fall 2021, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
