## Overnight Detour Scheduled Tonight at the State Road 16 Ramp to I-95 South

**ST. AUGUSTINE, Fla. –** As part of resurfacing improvements on I-95 from State Road 207 to International Golf Parkway, a closure of the State Road 16 on-ramp to I-95 South is necessary for barrier wall installation to be completed safely. The on-ramp will close at 8 p.m. on Tuesday, May 28 and reopen by 6 a.m. Wednesday, May 29.

During the closure, drivers on State Road 16 seeking to access I-95 South will use I-95 North and exit at International Golf Parkway to access I-95 South. Drivers are encouraged to use caution in the area and follow posted detour signs at this time.

Anderson Columbia Co. Inc. is estimated to complete the \$31 million resurfacing improvements by early 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
