Overnight Detours Planned Next Week at I-295 South Ramp to Beach Boulevard

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of resurfacing improvements on I-295 from Beach Boulevard to St. Johns Bluff Road, a closure of the Beach Boulevard exit ramp from I-295 South is necessary for milling and paving work to be completed. The ramp is scheduled to close nightly Monday, June 26 through Wednesday, June 28 at 9 p.m. and reopen by 6 a.m. the following morning.

During the overnight closures, motorists will be detoured to exit at Town Center Parkway and use St. Johns Bluff Road to access Beach Boulevard.

Preferred Materials, Inc. is expected to complete the \$10 million resurfacing improvement project by summer 2024, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. The improvements will include shoulder treatment, guardrail and drainage upgrades, new highway signage, lighting, and Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) construction.
