Overnight Detours Planned for I-95 at Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway Interchange Improvement Project

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of the interchange improvement project on Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway at I-95, nightly lane closures and detours are scheduled from Saturday, Aug. 17 through Friday, Aug. 23 for temporary lighting and barrier wall installation.

I-95 North from M.L.K. West Detour

The on-ramp to I-95 North from westbound Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway will close nightly Saturday, Aug. 17 through Friday, Aug. 23 between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. As a detour, drivers will use I-95 South to the 8th Street West exit to access I-95 North.

I-95 North and M.L.K. East Exit Ramp 354A Detour

The I-95 North outside lane and exit ramp 354A to eastbound Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway will close nightly Saturday, Aug. 17 through Friday, Aug. 23 between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. As a detour, drivers will use the Golfair Boulevard exit to Main Street south to access Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway.

I-95 South from M.L.K. East Detour

The on-ramp to I-95 South from eastbound Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway will close nightly Sunday, Aug. 18 through Friday, Aug. 23 between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. As a detour, drivers will use I-95 northbound to the Golfair Boulevard exit to access I-95 South.

Webber, LLC is estimated to complete the \$79.9 million interchange improvements by early 2027, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
