## Overnight Detours Planned for Next Week at the I-95/I-295 North Interchange

**JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** – FDOT will have multiple overnight closures and detours throughout the I-95/I-295 North Interchange Operational Improvements project beginning Sunday, Feb. 25 for overhead sign installation and roadway construction, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. Please note that times may be adjusted to avoid conflicting detour traffic along the routes.

Closures scheduled Sunday, Feb. 25 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning:

- **I-295 East closed:** Drivers will detour to the Duval Road exit, to Airport Road and take U.S. 17 to reconnect with I-295 East.
- **I-95 South closed:** Drivers will detour to the Airport Road exit, to U.S. 17 and take I-295 West to reconnect with I-95 South.
- I-95 South to I-295 East closed: Drivers will detour to the Airport Road exit and take U.S. 17 to connect with I-295 East.
- I-95 North to I-295 East closed: Drivers will detour to the Busch Drive exit and take U.S. 17 to connect with I-295 East.

Closure scheduled Monday, Feb. 26 through Thursday, Feb. 29 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning:

• I-295 East exit to I-95 North closed: Drivers will detour to the U.S. 17 exit and take I-295 West to connect to I-95 northbound.

Closure scheduled Monday, Feb. 26 and Tuesday, Feb. 27 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning:

• I-95 North closed: Drivers will detour to I-295 East, take the U.S. 17 exit and take Airport Road to reconnect with I-95 North.

This work is part of a new phase of construction on the I-95/I-295 North Interchange Operational Improvements project. The interchange upgrades are part of an important effort to promote economic growth and development in the region.
