Overnight Detours Planned for Next Week at the I-95/I-295 North Interchange

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – FDOT will have overnight closures and detours throughout the I-95/I-295 North Interchange Operational Improvements project beginning Sunday, Sept. 15 through Thursday, Sept. 19 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. for structure coating operations, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Drivers can expect intermittent, short duration detours on ramps throughout the I-95/I-295 North Interchange, as well as intermittent detours of I-95 North and South between Airport Road and Busch Drive, I-295 East and West from Pulaski Road to Duval Road, and the Cole Road overpass at I-95. Please plan accordingly and prepare for longer duration commutes through this area. FDOT encourages drivers to visit 511.com before their trip for up-to-date information on road closures.

Application of protective coatings is among the final steps of construction on new structures. Protective coatings prolong longevity and enhance the aesthetics of Florida's infrastructure, saving maintenance dollars and providing travelers with a more pleasurable commute. Only the I-295 bridges over U.S. 17 remain to be completed on the project and FDOT is finalizing construction on the newly completed structures.
