Overnight Detours on I-95/I-295 North Interchange Project Start Sunday

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – FDOT is scheduled to detour traffic on ramps at the I-95/I-295 North Interchange starting Sunday, Sept. 9 through Thursday, Sept. 14 for maintenance of traffic stripping work. These closures will only be implemented one at a time, with crews opening the ramps to traffic before the next closure.

The following detours are scheduled for overnight hours Sunday through Thursday from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.:

I-295 Westbound to I-95 Northbound: Drivers will detour to U.S. 17 and Airport Road to access I-95 northbound.

I-95 Southbound to I-295 Eastbound: Drivers will detour to Airport Road and U.S. 17 to access I-295 eastbound.

U.S. 17 to I-295 Eastbound: Drivers will detour to Eastport Road and Pulaksi Road to access I-295 eastbound.

I-295 Westbound to U.S. 17: Drivers will detour onto I-95 northbound to Airport Road to access U.S. 17.

I-295 Eastbound to U.S. 17: Drivers will detour to Pulaksi Road, I-295 westbound to access U.S. 17.

U.S. 17 to I-295 Westbound: Drivers will detour to I-295 eastbound and Pulaksi Road to access I-295 westbound.

This work is part of a new phase of construction on the I-95/I-295 North Interchange Operational Improvements project. The interchange upgrades are part of an important effort to promote economic growth and development in the region.
