


## **Overnight Detours on I-95/I-295 North Interchange Through Thursday**

**JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** – FDOT will detour traffic on I-95 and I-295 nightly through Thursday, April 20 as part of the new phase of construction activities on the I-95/I-295 North Interchange Operational Improvements Project.

As shown in the map below, I-95 northbound between Max Leggett Parkway and I-295 and the I-95 southbound ramp to I-295 westbound will be detoured nightly Sunday, April 16 through Thursday, April 20 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. Drivers will be detoured to I-295 eastbound and U.S. 17 to rejoin I-95 northbound.



As shown in the map below, the I-295 eastbound and westbound ramp to I-95 northbound will be detoured nightly Monday, April 17 through Thursday, April 20 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. for a traffic shift. Drivers will be detoured to U.S. 17 and Airport Road to rejoin I-95 northbound.



This shift is one of several scheduled over the next few months as FDOT transitions into a new phase of construction on the critical interchange updates. The interchange upgrades are part of an important effort to promote economic growth and development in the region.
