Overnight Closures and Traffic Shift Planned at I-295, U.S. 17 Interchange Jan. 14-17

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of the interchange improvement and resurfacing projects at I-295 and U.S. 17, overnight ramp closures for installation of temporary barrier wall are planned Sunday, Jan. 14 through Wednesday, Jan. 17, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

The ramp from southbound I-295 to U.S. 17 will close at 9 p.m. Sunday, Jan. 14 and reopen by 6 a.m. Monday, Jan. 15. Traffic on southbound I-295 seeking to exit on U.S. 17 will detour to San Jose Boulevard (State Road 13) and take northbound I-295 to access the U.S. 17 exit.

When the ramp reopens the morning of Monday, Jan. 15, drivers will no longer have access to the existing slip lane from southbound I-295 to southbound U.S. 17. Traffic exiting onto southbound U.S. 17 will be directed to a traffic signal at the bottom of the ramp with a “No Right Turn on Red” restriction. Drivers should expect increased congestion during this temporary phase of construction and plan their commutes accordingly.

The ramp from northbound U.S. 17 to southbound I-295 will close overnight Monday, Jan. 15 through Wednesday, Jan. 17. The ramp will close nightly at 9 p.m. and reopen by 6 a.m. the following day. Traffic on northbound U.S. 17 seeking to access southbound I-295 will detour via northbound I-295 to Blanding Boulevard (State Road 21) and back onto southbound I-295.
