Overnight Detour of Eastbound State Road 100 Planned for March 24

Detour will remain in place for large vehicles, oversize loads until spring 2023

STARKE, Fla. – As part of FDOT's Starke Railroad Overpass Interchange Improvements, eastbound State Road 100 between U.S. 301/Temple Avenue and Water Street will close at 8:30 p.m. on Thursday, March 24 and reopen by 6 a.m. Friday, March 25, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. The closure is necessary to accommodate a traffic shift for bridge foundation construction.


Eastbound State Road 100 Detour: Eastbound State Road 100 traffic will turn right onto southbound U.S. 301, then turn left onto SE 144th Avenue (Hazen Street) and continue onto SE 144th Street (Hazen Street) to rejoin State Road 100 (see map below).

Oversized Load and Large Vehicle Traffic Detour: Due to vertical clearance constraints, following the traffic shift on March 24, this eastbound State Road 100 detour is expected to remain in place day and night for all oversized loads and large vehicles through early spring 2023.

Westbound State Road 100 traffic will not be detoured; however, drivers should expect intermittent stops and delays as the traffic shift is implemented.
