Overnight Detours Planned for Ramp from Eastbound Butler Boulevard to Northbound San Pablo Road

Jacksonville, Fla. – As part of the Florida Department of Transportation’s interchange improvement project at J.T. Butler Boulevard (State Road 202) and San Pablo Road, traffic exiting eastbound Butler Boulevard onto northbound San Pablo Road will be detoured nightly Tuesday, October 13 through Friday, October 16, weather permitting.

From 8 p.m. through 6 a.m., all drivers exiting eastbound Butler Boulevard at San Pablo Road will be routed to southbound San Pablo Road. A marked U-turn will direct drivers wishing to travel north on San Pablo Road.

FDOT hired Watson Civil Construction to complete this \$12 million project, which includes construction of a diverging diamond interchange at San Pablo Road and Butler Boulevard, in spring of 2022, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
