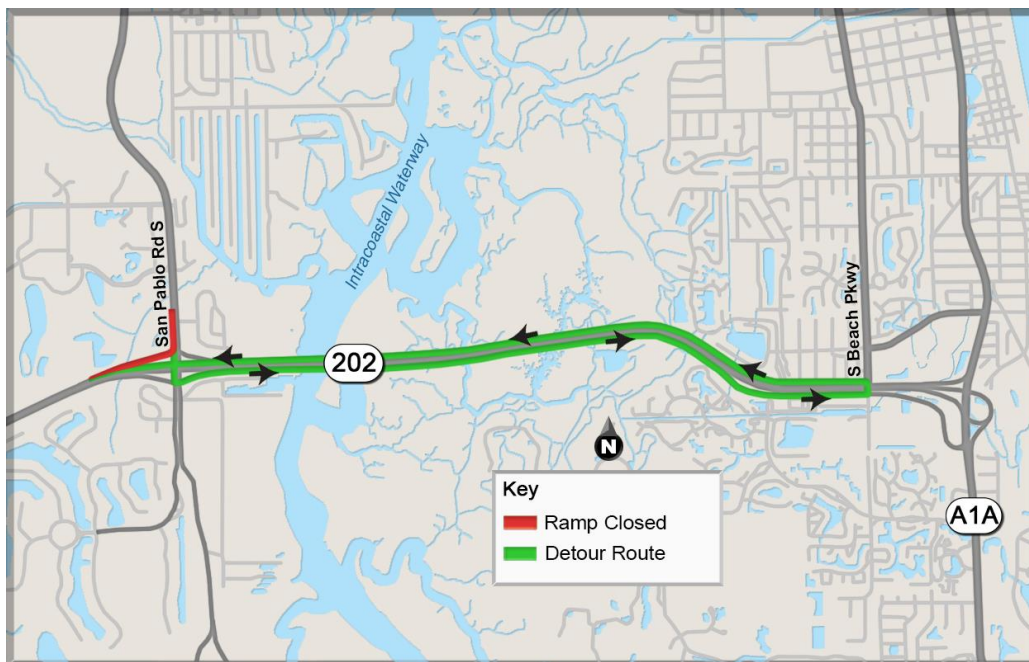

Overnight Ramp Closure Planned for San Pablo Road and Butler Boulevard

Jacksonville, Fla. – As part of the Florida Department of Transportation’s interchange improvement project at Butler Boulevard (State Road 202) and San Pablo Road, the ramp from San Pablo Road to westbound Butler Boulevard will close overnight starting at 8 p.m. Wednesday, June 24 and reopen by 6 a.m. Thursday, June 25, weather and schedule permitting. The closure will allow for installation of a 24-inch water main across the ramp.

Detour: To access westbound Butler Boulevard, drivers will be detoured to eastbound Butler Boulevard, where they will continue to the South Beach Parkway exit and turn left onto South Beach Parkway to access the ramp onto westbound Butler Boulevard.



FDOT hired Watson Civil Construction to complete this \$12 million project, which includes construction of a diverging diamond interchange at San Pablo Road and Butler Boulevard, in spring of 2022, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
