### **FDOT to install new safety device on I-10 exit ramp warning motorists to slow down**

**Jacksonville**—The Florida Department of Transportation has begun installing a new Activated Traffic Calming Sign on the I-10 westbound exit ramp to I-295 south which began Monday November 19.

The solar powered electronic sign on the I-10 westbound exit ramp to I-295 detects and displays vehicle speed up to 45 mph. If the vehicle exceeds 45 mph, the sign will change to “Slow Down,” warning drivers they are above the advised speed for the curve on the I-10 exit ramp. The sign will also have a static curve warning sign mounted on top.

The contractor for this project is Florida Safety Contractors. The work also includes milling and resurfacing of I-10 westbound to I-295 southbound.

This sign installation is part of a district-wide Safety Push Button contact, which works to improve safety on the roads in Northeast Florida.

The Florida Department of Transportation urges motorists to always follow the speed limit and stay within the limits of orange cones and barrels while traveling through construction zones.
