Detour Planned for I-95 North to I-10 Flyover

Jacksonville, Fla. – As part of the Florida Department of Transportation’s 1-10/I-95 Operational Improvements project, the I-95 north to I-10 flyover will be detoured January 18 from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. as crews prepare to pour concrete on the I-95 north to I-10 flyover ramp. I-95 north will remain open.

I-95 north to I-10 west: I-95 north drivers who wish to take I-10 west will be detoured to the Park Street exit. At the bottom of the ramp, drivers will be able to take a right turn onto Park Street north toward Forest Street, then take a left turn onto Forest Street west to connect to the I-10 west ramp. (See map below.)

Alternate route for truckers: Truckers traveling north on I-95 who wish to take I-10 west are advised to take an alternate route by using the I-295 West Beltway towards Orange Park and use the I-10/I-295 West Beltway interchange.
