Ramp from San Pablo Road to Westbound Butler Boulevard to Close Overnight for Paving Work

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of the interchange improvement project at J. Turner Butler Boulevard (State Road 202) and San Pablo Road, the ramp from San Pablo Road to westbound Butler Boulevard will be closed for paving work from 8 p.m. tonight through 5 a.m. Friday, June 17, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Traffic will be detoured to eastbound Butler Boulevard to South Beach Parkway, where drivers can access westbound Butler Boulevard.

FDOT selected Watson Civil Construction, Inc. to complete this \$12 million project in summer 2022, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
