
Reconstruction Work on River Trail at U.S. 17 Scheduled to Begin Monday

Palatka, Fla. – As part of the Florida Department of Transportation's roadway widening project on U.S. 17 from Horse Landing Road to the north approach of the Dunns Creek Bridge, access to River Trail from U.S. 17 will be temporarily closed Monday through Friday, May 17, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

The detour is necessary to reconstruct the River Trail approach to the new southbound U.S. 17 travel lanes. Motorists will detour to Marina Road and Landmark Avenue to travel back to River Trail.

GLF Construction began the \$36.5 million project in February 2018 and is expected to be completed by summer 2021, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
