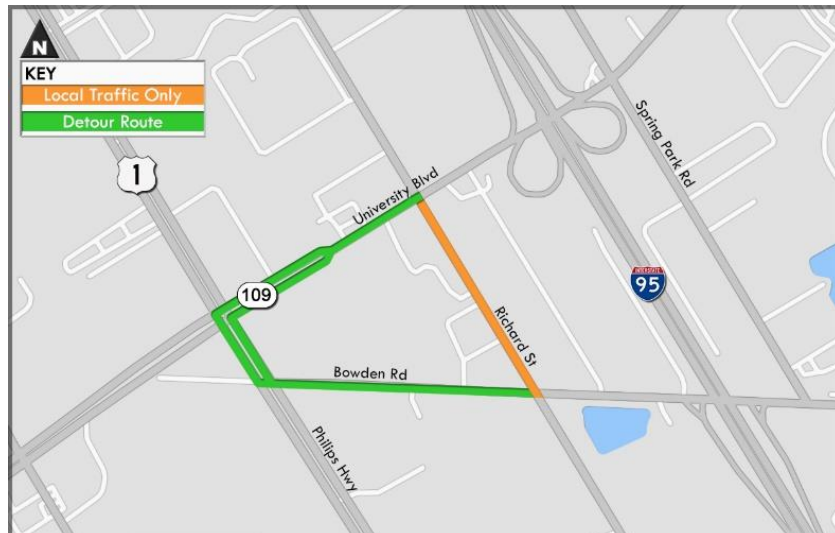
Richard Street to See Overnight Detours Next Week

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of FDOT’s University Boulevard signals improvements project, Richard Street will be closed to through traffic April 5-9 from 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. for underground signals work.

Drivers who wish to take Richard Street will be detoured to Philips Highway to connect with University Boulevard or Bowden Road (see map below). Richard Street will remain open to local traffic.

Traffic Control Devices Inc. is expected to complete this \$4 million improvement project in spring 2021, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
