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
### ICYMI: Detours Planned for I-95 South at the Fuller Warren Bridge

**Jacksonville, Fla.** – As part of the Florida Department of Transportation’s 1-10/I-95 Operational Improvements project, I-95 south will be detoured Friday, August 9 from 10:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. as crews remove an overhead sign structure and repaint lane lines.

I-95 Southbound: Drivers will be detoured to Forest Street to Riverside Avenue to the Acosta Bridge where traffic can rejoin I-95 southbound.

I-10 Eastbound: Drivers attempting to travel onto I-95 southbound will be detoured at the I-95 interchange to Forest Street, then to Riverside Avenue and onto the Acosta Bridge where traffic can rejoin I-95 southbound.

I-10 Eastbound Alternate: Drivers may also continue onto I-95 north to the Union Street exit, then turn right onto North Jefferson Street onto the Acosta Bridge where they can join I-95 southbound.



Law enforcement officers will be on site to ensure the safety of drivers and construction crews.

FDOT hired Archer Western as the contractor to complete this project for \$126 million with completion anticipated in summer 2020, depending on weather, holidays and unforeseen circumstances.
