### **Southside Connector at Regency Square Boulevard North Overnight Ramp Closures Scheduled August 15 and 16**

**JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** – The Southside Connector (State Road 113) northbound and southbound ramps at Regency Square Boulevard North are scheduled to close overnight Sunday, August 15 and Monday, August 16. The ramps will close in shifts between 7 p.m. and 7 a.m. each night, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. The detours are necessary for guardrail work associated with the Southside Connector resurfacing and improvement project.

Regency Square Boulevard North traffic seeking to travel north on Southside Connector will be detoured to Monument Road and Tredinick Parkway.

Southside Connector northbound traffic to Regency Square Boulevard will continue north on Southside Connector and detour using Tredinick Parkway and Monument Road.

Southside Connector southbound traffic from Regency Square Boulevard will detour to Monument Road, Tredinick Parkway and the Southside Connector Service Road to Southside Connector southbound.

Signage will direct motorists through the detours. Motorists on Southside Connector will not be impacted. Detours and closures are shown in the map below.


