State Road 230 Marking Operations Scheduled May 7-10

STARKE, Fla. – As part of the Florida Department of Transportation's Starke Railroad Overpass Interchange Improvements project, final pavement marking operations will take place on Call Street (State Road 230) between U.S. 301 and St. Clair Street overnight on Sunday, May 7, during the day on Monday, May 8 and overnight Tuesday, May 9, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. During operations, drivers should expect intermittent, one block, single-lane closures with flaggers present.

FDOT hired J.B. Coxwell Contracting to complete this \$23.6 million project in summer 2023, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
