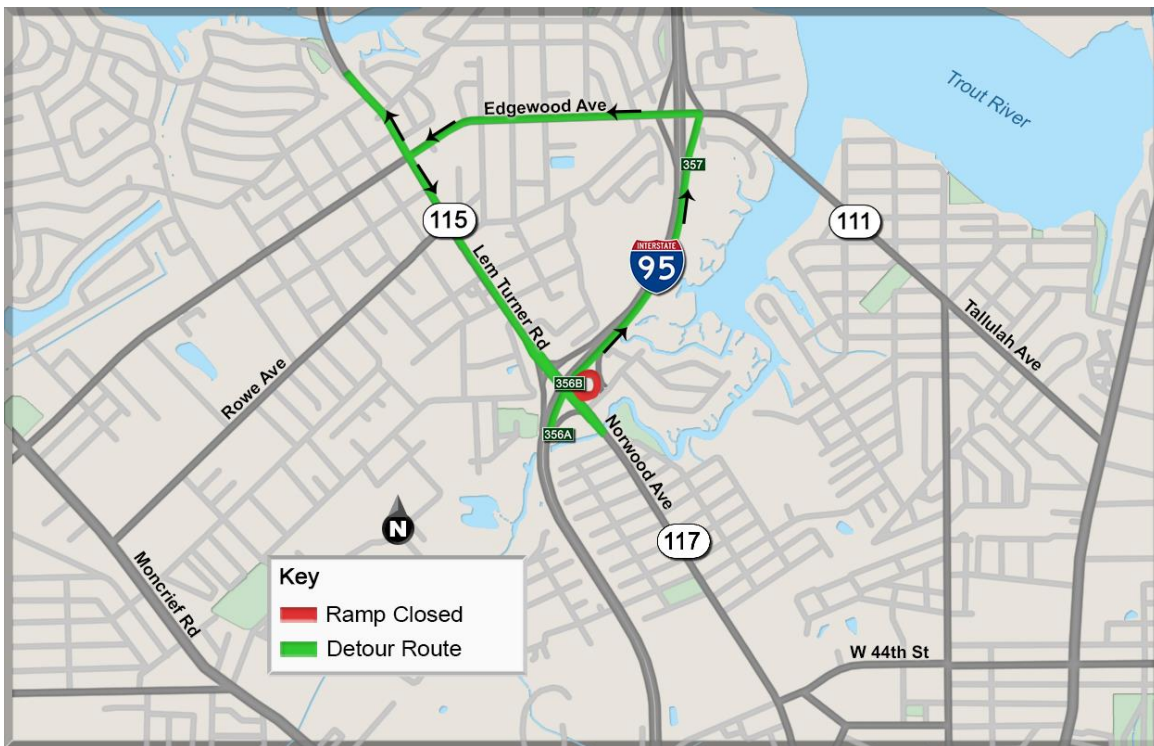

TRAVEL ADVISORY: I-95 northbound off-ramp at Lem Turner Road to Temporarily close Monday Night

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – The I-95 northbound off-ramp to Lem Turner Road (Exit 356B) will be closed Monday, October 26, from 6:30 p.m. to 6:30 a.m. for paving operations, weather permitting. Traffic will detour north to Edgewood Avenue (Exit 357) and continue west on Edgewood Avenue towards Lem Turner Road.
