TRAVEL ADVISORY: Northbound I-95 Ramp to Eastbound MLK Parkway to see detour

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – The northbound I-95 ramp to eastbound Martin Luther King, Jr. Parkway/U.S. 1 (Exit 354A) will be closed for an indefinite period as crews excavate and fill a depression in the roadway. A metal plate had been placed over the depression; however, the closure is necessary for crews to safely improve the roadway.

Signage will be placed on I-95 to alert drivers of the closure and detour signs will direct drivers through the detour route.
