### **Temporary Closures and Detours at the Edgewood Avenue South Corridor and Roundabout in Place June 8 to June 14**

**JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** – Detours will be in place at the intersection of Edgewood Avenue South and Roosevelt Boulevard (U.S. 17) for roundabout striping and completion of bridge cleaning and painting for one week, from Saturday, June 8 to Friday, June 14, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. Drivers should follow posted detour signage and use additional caution in the area.

Additionally, the inside lanes on Edgewood Avenue from Antisdale Street to Lenox Avenue will also be closed continuously between June 8 and June 14 for median island construction, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

During construction, Edgewood Avenue South between Mayflower Street and the railroad track will be closed to truck traffic. Deliveries in the area should seek alternate routes.
