
## Temporary Closures and Detours to Start March 18 in the Edgewood Avenue South Corridor

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of the Florida Department of Transportation's Edgewood Avenue South from Roosevelt Boulevard to Cassat Avenue Roadway Improvements project and the Edgewood Avenue South Rail Crossing Rehabilitation project. In total, closures and detours will be used for rail crossing rehabilitation, construction of a roundabout and bridge painting over and 8-week period starting March 18, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Traffic is encouraged to use posted detours during closures.

Due to closure for roundabout traffic configuration construction and bridge painting, Edgewood Avenue South between Mayflower Street and the railroad tracks will be closed to truck traffic. Deliveries should seek alternate routes in the area.

Starting March 18 at 6 a.m. and continuing for approximately 10 days, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting, the following closure will be in place during rail crossing rehabilitation:

From Fridays at 3 p.m. to Sundays at 8 p.m., the following traffic configuration will be in place in the Edgewood Avenue South corridor:
