## **Temporary Median Closure at Blanding Boulevard and Long Bay Road to Begin Monday Night**

**MIDDLEBURG, Fla.** – As part of the Blanding Boulevard (State Road 21) widening and reconstruction project between Allie Murray Road and Long Bay Road, crews will close the median opening at Blanding Boulevard and Long Bay Road at approximately 7 p.m. Monday, July 18 to allow for reconstruction work. The closure is anticipated to last up to one week, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. During the closure, motorists will be restricted to right turns only at the intersection.

FDOT selected R.B. Baker Construction Company to complete this \$19.1 million project in summer 2022, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
