Traffic Shift on Northbound I-95 St. Marys River Scheduled to Begin Feb. 12

NASSAU COUNTY, Fla. – A traffic shift on northbound I-95 at the St. Marys River bridge will begin Wednesday, Feb. 12 and remain in place through March, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. Drivers should use extra caution and follow speed limits and other signage when navigating the area.

The project to rehabilitate and resurface the St. Marys River Bridge on I-95 at the Florida/Georgia state line is scheduled to be completed this summer. Improvements under this project include rehabilitation of the original fender system, removal of diaphragms, the addition of concrete deck overlay and other incidental construction.

Traffic will be maintained in accordance with FDOT design standards throughout the project.

Seacoast Inc. was awarded the \$5.94 million improvement project and is expected to complete work in summer 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
