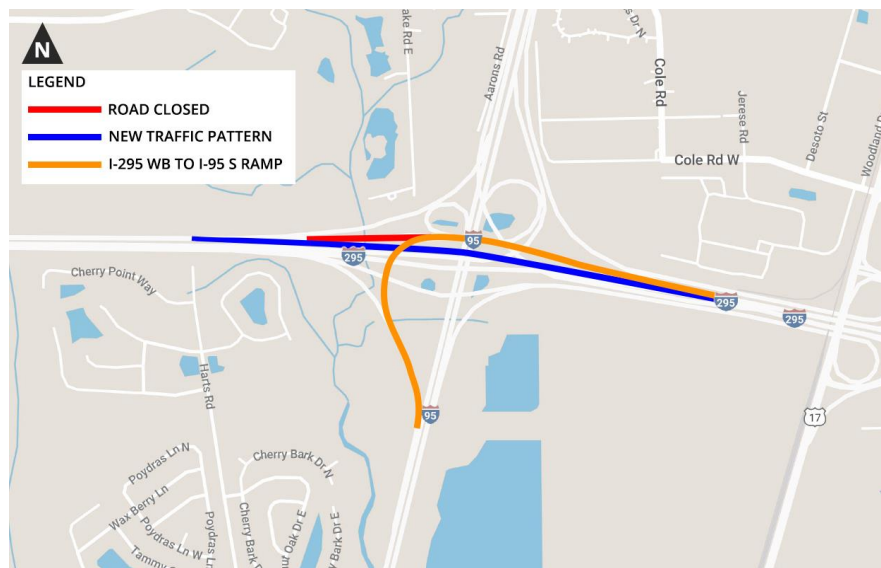

Traffic Shift and Overnight Detours on I-95/I-295 North Interchange Start Sunday

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – Lanes of I-295 westbound will shift onto new roadway near the I-95 interchange Sunday, Oct. 8 as part of the I-95/I-295 North Interchange Operational Improvements Project.

As shown in the map below, drivers on I-295 westbound will be shifted into a new traffic pattern. This traffic shift will not impact I-295 westbound drivers attempting to exit onto I-95 southbound. While the shift is being implemented, drivers will be detoured to I-95 northbound, Airport Road and I-295 southbound to access I-295 westbound.



In addition to the traffic shift, I-295 eastbound between Pulaski Road and Biscayne Boulevard will be detoured Sunday, Oct. 8 through Thursday, Oct. 12 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. Drivers will be detoured Duval Road, Airport Road and I-95 southbound to access I-295 eastbound.

I-295 eastbound ramp to I-95 northbound will be detoured Sunday, Oct. 8 through Thursday, Oct. 12 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. Drivers will be detoured to U.S. 17 and I-295 westbound ramp to access I-95 northbound.

This work is part of a new phase of construction on the I-95/I-295 North Interchange Operational Improvements project. The interchange upgrades are part of an important effort to promote economic growth and development in the region.
