Traffic Shift for U.S. 1 Travel Lanes Scheduled Jan. 21 to Complete Concrete Rehabilitation Work

ST. AUGUSTINE, Fla. – As part of the U.S. 1 (State Road 5) from State Road 207 to the St. Augustine City Gates resurfacing project, northbound travel lanes of U.S. 1 from Malaga Street to West Castillo Drive will be shifted toward the median for crews to safely complete concrete work and remove steel plates from the outside lane.

Northbound U.S. 1 travel lanes will be shifted toward the inside lanes overnight on Sunday, Jan. 21. This phase of construction is temporary and is expected to be in place for approximately one week, weather and schedule unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Kiewit Infrastructure South Company is estimated to complete the \$15 million improvements by late summer 2024, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
