### **Traffic Shift of I-10 Westbound Lanes Just West of Yellow Water Road Scheduled August 8**

**JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** – As part of the I-10 and U.S. 301 interchange improvement project, westbound travel lanes of I-10 just west of Yellow Water Road will be shifted to the right of the existing travel lanes Sunday, August 8. The traffic shift is necessary for construction crews to complete work on I-10 just east of the CSX railyard.

To safely implement the traffic shift, nighttime lane closures will be necessary on I-10 westbound from the Yellow Water Road Bridge to just west of the U.S. 301 interchange from 8 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

Superior Construction Company began the \$65 million interchange improvement project in late February 2016 and is estimated to complete the work in summer 2023. Construction completion estimates are fluid and subject to change, weather and schedule permitting.
