Travel Advisory: I-295 Southbound Ramp to J. Turner Butler Boulevard Eastbound Closed Tuesday and Wednesday Nights

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – The I-295 southbound ramp to J. Turner Butler Boulevard (State Road 202) eastbound is scheduled to close overnight Tuesday, February 2 and Wednesday, February 3 from 9:30 p.m. to 4:30 a.m. for routine bridge maintenance.

Traffic will detour west on Butler Boulevard to Gate Parkway and the eastbound Butler Boulevard ramp.
